#### Another reason to Sing for the LORD

Children who sing in choruses have greater academic success and more advanced social skills than children who don't sing, a <u>national study by Chorus America</u> has found. Large majorities of parents and educators surveyed for the study attributed a significant part of a child's academic success to singing in a choir.

The results show children who sing in choirs display many of the enhanced social skills found in adult singers, substantiating earlier conclusions that singing in childhood is likely to have an enormous influence on the choices individuals make later in life.

Children who sing in choruses have academic success and valuable life skills. The majority of parents surveyed believe multiple skills increased after their child joined a chorus. Seventy-one percent said their child had become more self-confident, 70% that self-discipline had improved, and 69% that the child's memory skills had improved.

More than 80% of educators surveyed -

across multiple academic disciplines - agreed with parent assessments that choir participation enhanced numerous aspects of a child's social development and academic success. Educators also observed that children who sang were better participants in group activities, had better emotional expression and exhibited better emotional management. Children who participated in a chorus had significantly better grades than those who had never sung in a choir.

The study report said the decline in choral singing opportunities for children was of concern.

We are truly blessed to be able to provide choral opportunities within our church. Children are the voices of our future and our future leaders.

Under the direction of Mr. Joe Luechauer supported on piano by Mrs. Pauline Luechauer, your child will be exposed to a quality musical experience! Singing not only glorifies Our Heavenly Father, it helps prepare our kids for future success!

#### **DEVILED EGGS WITH A KICK** FROM PREVENTION MAGAZINE

6 Eggs, hard-cooked

- 2 Tablespoons of light mayonnaise
- 1/4 Teaspoon chili powder + more for garnish
- 1 Scallion, finely chopped
- 1 Tablespoon chopped cilantro

Shell the eggs, Place 2 eggs in a shallow bowl. Cut the remaining 4 eggs into halves lengthwise. Remove the yolks and add to the eggs in the bowl. With a fork or pastry blender, mash the eggs and yolks in the bowl. Add the mayonnaise and 1/4 teaspoon chili power.

Stir to mix. Place the egg white halves on a plate, hollow side up. Dollop the yolk mixture into the hollows. Scatter the scallion and the cilantro on

top. Plate with chili power. Enjoy!
